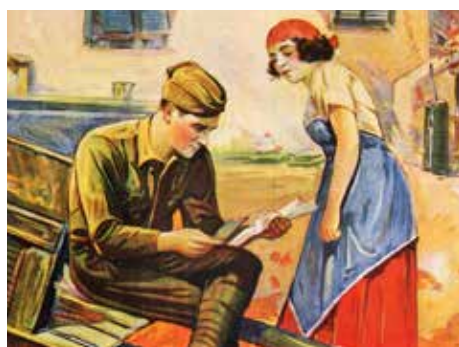
SCHEDULE OF SERVICES & EVENTS
